Programmes organized:

- The year began with the annual N.C.C. exhibition which was a magnificent display of the sophisticated arms & weapons of the Indian army & of the glorious past and activities of the NCC units of S.I.E.S College.
- To commemorate the death of Field Marshal Sam Manekshaw our unit had organized an event wherein a guard of honour was given to the late Field Marshal and a mock combat scenario was created in the college quadrangle to display the counter-insurgency operations of the Indian Army. Also a display of defense was given by the NCC cadets. The events received media coverage with newspaper such as the Times of India, the Indian Express, Yuva and Mid-day carrying reports and pictures of the event.
- We organized the 15th August celebration in the college wherein 53 cadets were sworn in and the oath taking ceremony was presided by our honourable Principal Dr.Harsha Mehta. Later in the evening, our NCC cadets gave a guard honour to our ex-President Dr.A.P.J Abdul Kalam at a function in SIES Nerul campus.
- The Boys' Unit led a team of 53 Cadets for a two-day hike to Bhimashankar.
- Actively helped in organizing Visions and other programmes in the college.

Rallies, Workshops, Camps and other activities:

- ❖ Five of our cadets were selected for national summer training camp at Panchgani organized by the 22nd Maharashtra Battalion where they received training in rappelling, river crossing, valley crossing, rock climbing, dand-patta(traditional weapon),sword fighting, handling traditional weapons and daggers.
- ❖ Seven cadets were selected for National Shivaji Trail Trek spanning over 15 days measuring a distance of over 300 Km and seeing an expanse of over 11 forts conquered by Shivaji.
- ❖ Five of our cadets after a rigorous selection process were selected for one of the most coveted camps in NCC-'The Army Attachment Camp', Nagpur .During their stay of 12 days with the Indian Army, our cadets were trained rigorously and were given an opportunity to fire the most sophisticated rifle inducted into the army-'The'INSAS'.
- ❖ Various Annual Training Camps were held where our cadets actively participated. Associate NCC officer [ANO] Major S.H. Bohra was also in a camp as a 'Deputy Camp Commandant' and was well appreciated by Commanding Office Col. Dharam Narain for his work during the camp.
- ❖ Other training courses such as flood relief, fire fighting, disaster management, etc. were conducted at the battalion.

- ❖ Boys of our NCC unit were a part of security arrangement at the Shivaji Maidan, Dadar where a conference against terrorism was held by the Mumbai University.
- ❖ Cadets participated in various social activities like Blood donation Camp held at INHS Asvini at Colaba and also in the college.
- ❖ NCC cadets of our college helped Mumbai Police several times during festivals such as “Ganesh Chaturti”, “Durgashtami”, etc in which they had to control crowds in those days during peak hours from 12 noon to 11pm. Their efforts were hugely appreciated by the authorities.
- ❖ Twenty cadets participated in the ”Save Girl Child rally” organized at Girgaon by Maharashtra DTE.
- ❖ Our NCC cadets participated in the walkathon-an anti tobacco rally organized by SIES institute.
- ❖ Our cadets gave a guard of honour to the martyrs of the 26/11 terror attack in the presence of honourable Governor of Maharashtra Shri S.C.Jamir.

The personal achievements of our cadets during this year are as follows:-
