

## **T. V. CHIDAMBARAN (1918 -1989 )**

Shri T.V. Chidambaran was the Registrar of the Bombay University for over two decades. He was intimately connected with the growth of this premier University. After retirement, he was a member of its Senate and Executive Council for several years. His vast experience, expertise, and knowledge of the University were always a great help and guidance in arriving at the right decisions affecting the colleges, Teachers and students. His report on University Administration Reforms continues to be the best reference for University Managements throughout the country.

He was associated with the SIES for over 30 years and was instrumental in founding the SIES College of Arts, Science and Commerce in 1960. He was its President between 1977-1982 and 1989. He passed away on 29<sup>th</sup> November 1989. To perpetuate his memory and good deeds, the Society organizes a Memorial lecture every year in the College Campus.
